Since the spring of 2020, our care has evolved to ensure our services were available and safe throughout the COVID-19 public health emergency. As the surge of the COVID-19 Omicron variant subsides, our Affinia Healthcare Clinical Council has suggested the following updates. The recommendations below have been accepted and are implemented immediately.

For in-person or telehealth appointments, call 314-814-8700.

- **In-person same day visits (primary care walk-in visits) are reinstated.**
- **Telehealth is available for same-day and appropriate medical and behavioral health appointments.**
- **In-person group care services are again available. Surge planning may include a virtual plan when needed.**
- **Surgical/medical masks are required of all individuals over 2 years in our buildings. Affinia Healthcare will provide the mask if needed.**
- **Patients may be accompanied by a limit of one (1) visitor. Children under an adult patient's care may accompany.**
- **Urgent Care continues to be open at 2220 Lemp. Individuals with COVID-like symptoms will receive Urgent Care via telehealth (a pilot program for in-person visits with COVID-like symptoms is underway).**

The safety and protection of our staff, patients and visitors at Affinia Healthcare continues to be of utmost importance during the COVID-19 public health emergency. As always, we balance this expectation with our vital mission in the communities we serve.
