## COVID-19 Vaccine Boosters

June 1, 2022

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has issued recommendations for COVID-19 vaccine boosters, as follows:

**Pfizer** COVID-19 vaccine boosters can be received by individuals 5 years and older, **after 5 months or more from receiving the second dose. A second booster (or 4<sup>th</sup> dose) is available if over 50 years 4 months after the 1<sup>st</sup> booster.** A parent or guardian must be present for a minor under 18 years.

**The Moderna** COVID-19 vaccine boosters can be received by adults 5 months after the first series and a second booster if over 50 years 4 months after the first.

**Johnson & Johnson** COVID-19 vaccine booster can be received **2 months or more after receiving the first dose**, for individuals who are 18+ years old. An additional booster of Pfizer or Moderna may be received 4 months after the first booster.

Children (5 and over) and adults **may be eligible for quicker/additional boosters** if they are immunocompromised.

Eligible individuals **may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose**, as CDC recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

**COVID-19 and Influenza (flu) Vaccines are provided at Affinia Healthcare locations and hours listed on the COVID-19 page of our website.**

There is no out-of-pocket cost for COVID-19 vaccines. However, we do ask patients to provide their proof of I.D., and their health insurance information (if applicable), for billing purposes.
