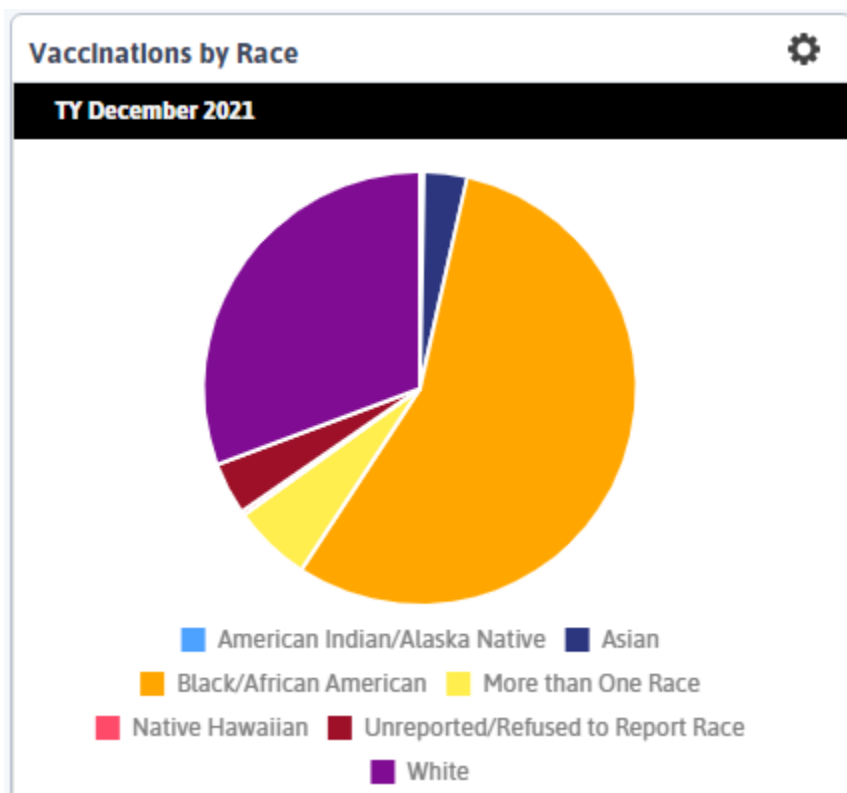
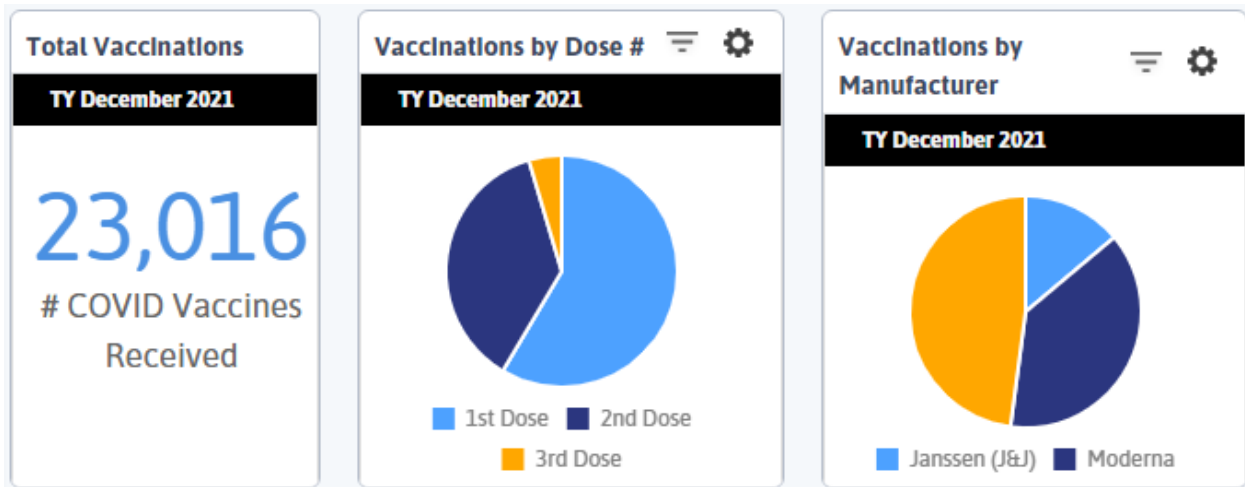


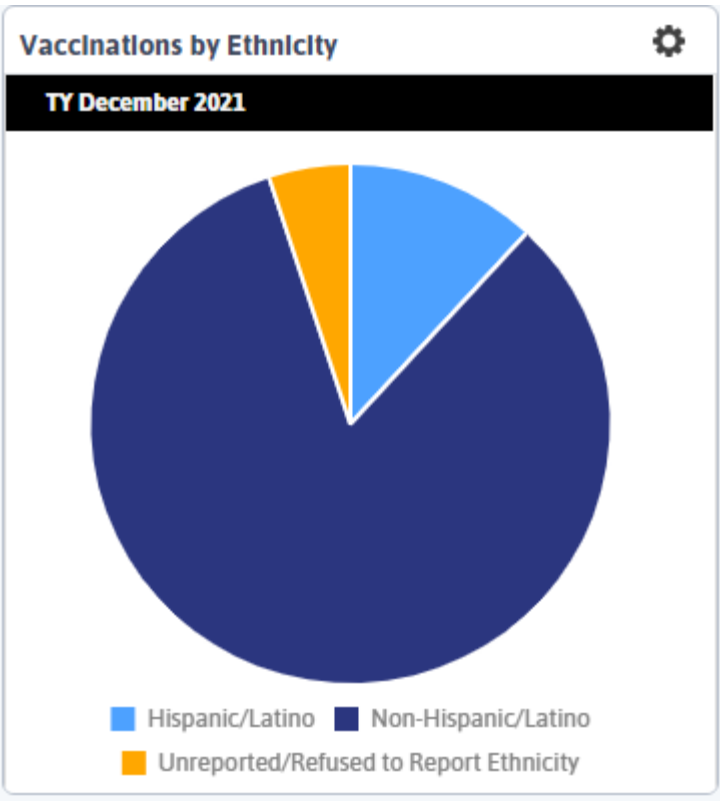

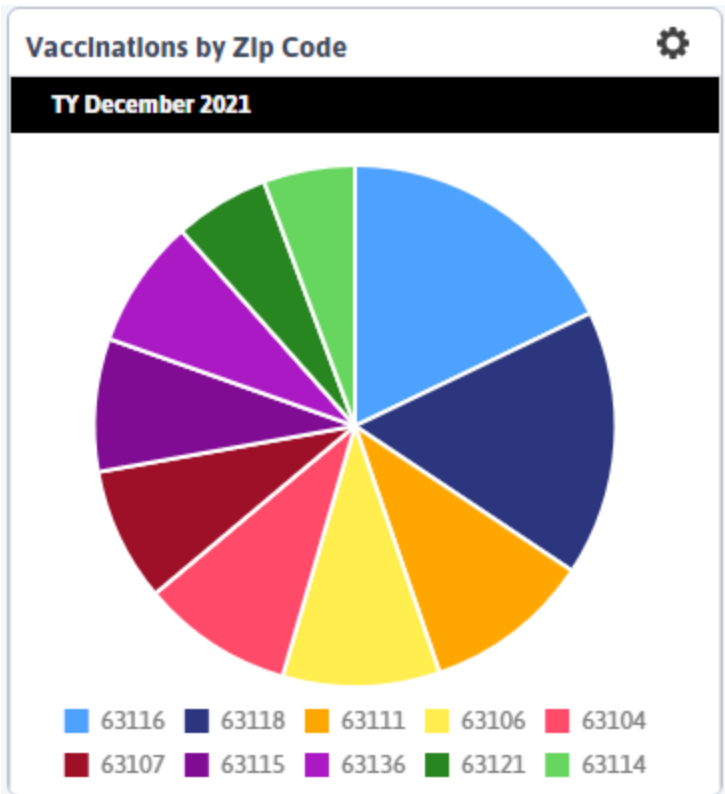
### Quality in COVID-19 Vaccinations

Covid-19 Vaccinations administered through December 2021 (these graphs represent patients + community response)

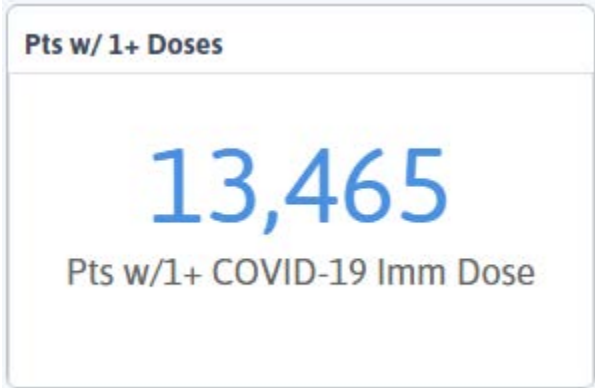




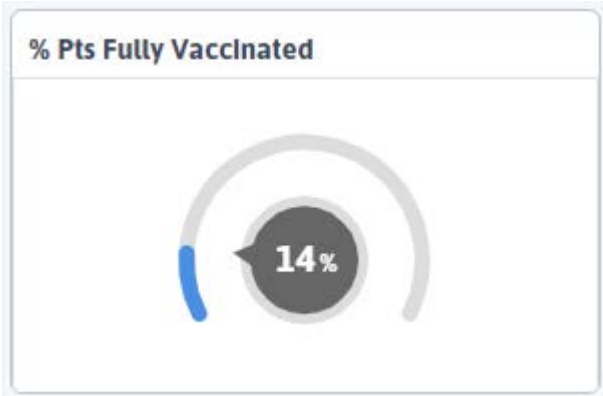
Zip codes receiving the highest percentage of the vaccine administered by Affinia Healthcare:

### Pts Receiving Vaccination by Ethnicity



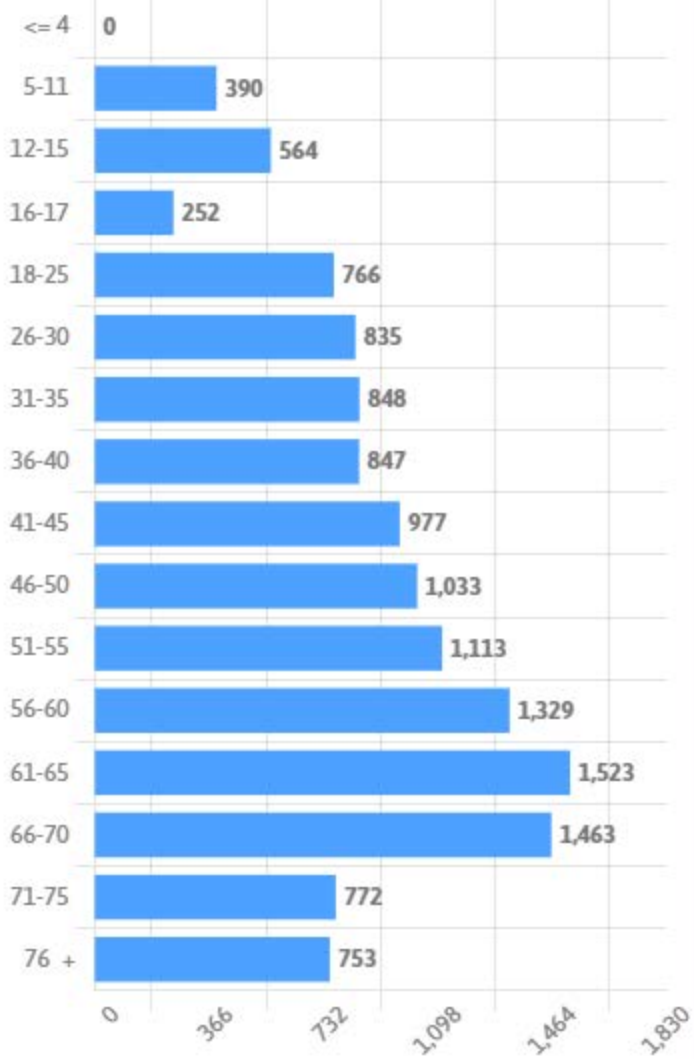
